ARTEMISIA, HEROINE OF ART

19 MARCH - 3 AUGUST 2025

Artemisia Gentileschi (1593-c. 1656) was one of the few women artists of the modern era to live off her paintings, thanks to her international success. She was a prominent figure in Caravaggesque painting and was particularly celebrated for her portrayals of heroines and her portrait work. This exhibition revisits Artemisia's work alongside paintings by artists close to her, such as her father Orazio and the French painter Simon Vouet.



GEORGES DE LA TOUR

SEPTEMBER 11, 2025 - JANUARY 25, 2026

Since the rediscovery of his work in the twentieth century, Georges de La Tour (1593-1651) has been acknowledged as one of the greatest French painters. With a selection of signed paintings and works by Italian, French, and Nordic artists the exhibition will retrace the career of the highly unusual and fascinating painter from Lorraine. Presented in thematic sections, the exhibition will present Georges de La Tour's favourite subjects, such as penitent saints, cheaters, and beggars, by placing them in the context of the spread of Caravaggism in Europe.
